Annual General Meeting Motions

The province rewrote the Society Act in 2016 and replaced it with the Societies Act. Each Society must go through a process of re-registration and transition to the new Act. As part of the process, the ATA Handbook has been revised, and a motion will be presented that the AGM adopts the revised Handbook. Copies of the proposed revision will be e-mailed to all members, and printed copies will be mailed to members without e-mail.

Another motion will be presented saying that the ATA wants to continue with the transition from the Society Act to the Societies Act.

A further motion will state that the ATA is a non-member funded Society.

The Annual General meeting will occur on November 14th.
